


# DDA regulations

## Technical data sheet



### Description

It is important to understand that all manifestation and graphics to glass screens and doors must comply with a minimum requirement by law. This is known as the Building Regulations 2000.

The Building Regulations 2000, Part M states; **2.24** *Glass entrance doors and glazed screens will satisfy Requirement M1 or M2 if:*

*a. They are clearly defined with manifestation on the glass at two levels, 850 to 1000mm and 1400 to 1600mm above the floor, contrasting visually with the*

*background seen through the glass (both from inside and outside) in all lighting conditions;*

*b. Manifestation takes the form of a logo or sign at least 150mm high (repeating if on glazed screen), or a decorative feature such as broken lines or continuous bands, at least 50mm high*
